Job Description: The Health Science Teacher is to teach assigned courses within the Career and Technical Education Department. Courses to be taught for the 2022-2023 school year are Medical Terminology and Principles of Healthcare. Teacher is to create a classroom environment for students to learn effectively. Teacher will follow Indiana State Standards for courses taught.

Required Qualifications:

- Valid teaching license in Indiana in area of study required, CTE: Health Occupations 5-12 or Workplace Specialist: Health Science – Nursing 9-12
- Experience in long-term care facility highly preferred
- Experience teaching in urban school setting preferred
- Must be a Registered Nurse

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Teaches District approved curriculum.
2. Coordinates clinical site visits for Certified Nursing Students and oversees clinical experience.
3. Creates a classroom environment that is conducive to learning and appropriate to the maturity and interests of the students.
4. Prepares for classes assigned.
5. Takes all necessary and reasonable precautions to protect students, equipment, materials, and facilities.
6. Experience in Skyward Student Management and Canvas.
7. Employs a variety of instructional techniques and instructional media, consistent with the physical limitations of the location provided and the needs and capabilities of the individuals or student groups.
8. Guides the learning process toward the achievement of curriculum goals and in harmony with the goals—established clear objectives for all lessons, units, projects, and the like to communicate these objectives to students.
9. Assists the administration in implementing all policies and rules governing student life and conduct, and, for the classroom, develops reasonable rules of classroom behavior and procedure, and maintains order in the classroom in a fair and just manner.
10. Assesses the accomplishments of students on a regular basis and provides progress reports as required.
11. Evaluates pupils' academic and social growth, keeps appropriate records and prepares progress reports.
12. Encourages students to set and maintain standards of classroom behavior.
13. Diagnoses the learning disabilities of students on a regular basis, seeking the assistance of district specialists as required.

14. Maintains accurate, complete, and correct records as required by law, district policy, and administrative regulations.

15. Is available to students and parents for education-related purposes outside the instructional day.

16. Performs other related duties, as assigned for the purpose of ensuring the efficient and effective functioning of the school duties.
